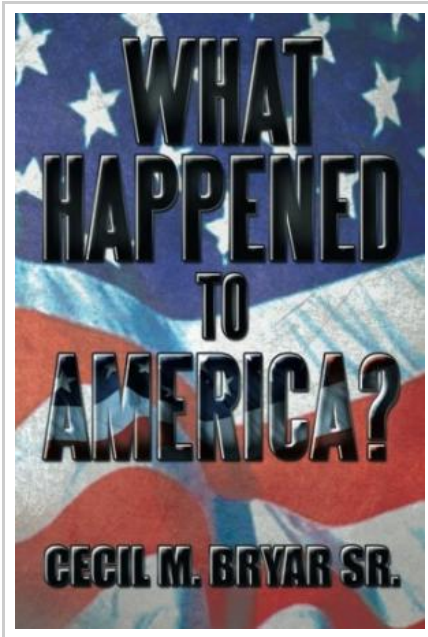




What Happened to America?
