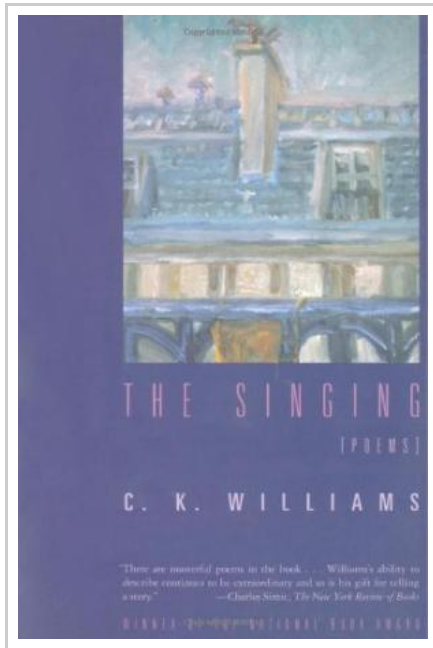




The Singing: Poems (Paperback)
