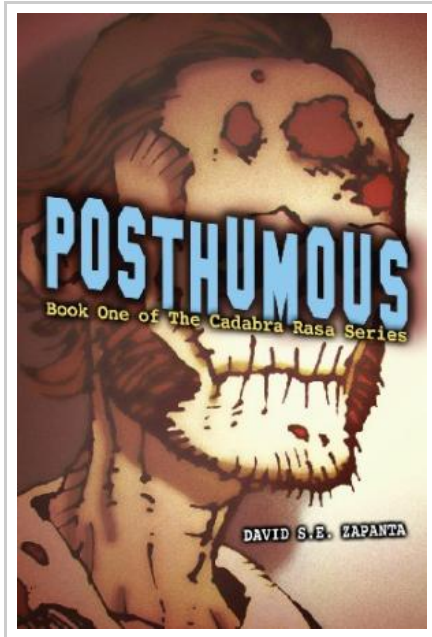




Posthumous: Book One
