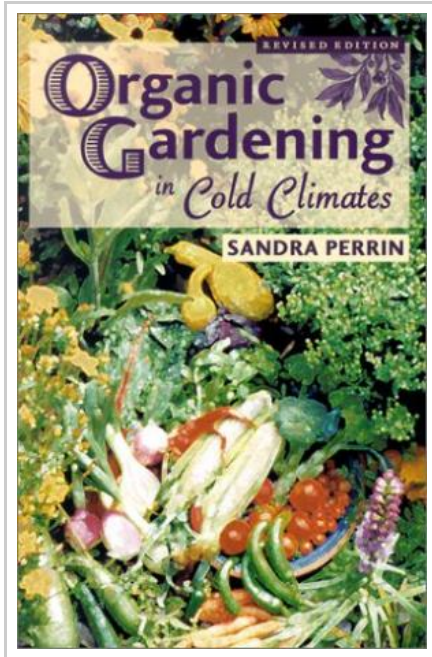




Organic Gardening in Cold Climates
