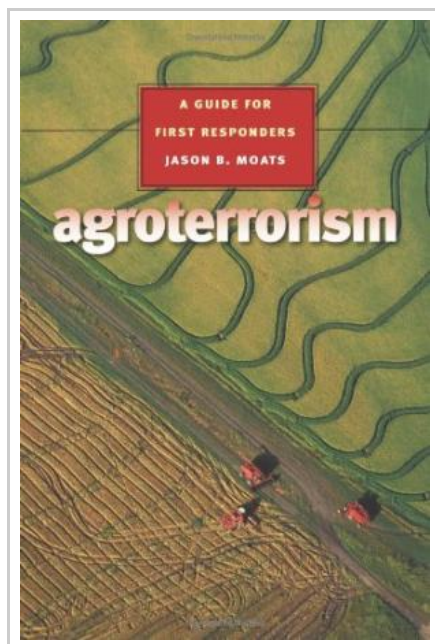




Agroterrorism: A Guide for First Responders (annotated edition)
