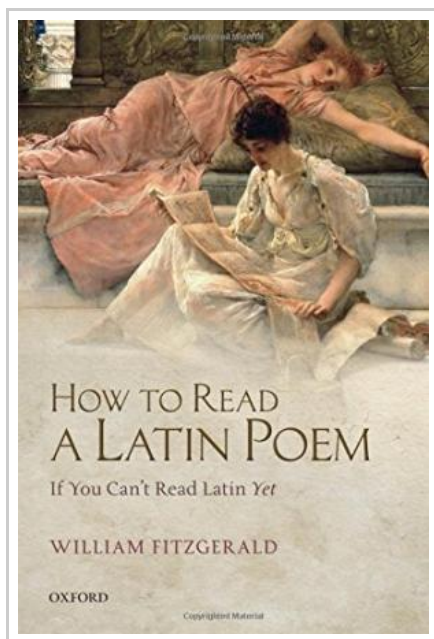




How to Read a Latin Poem
