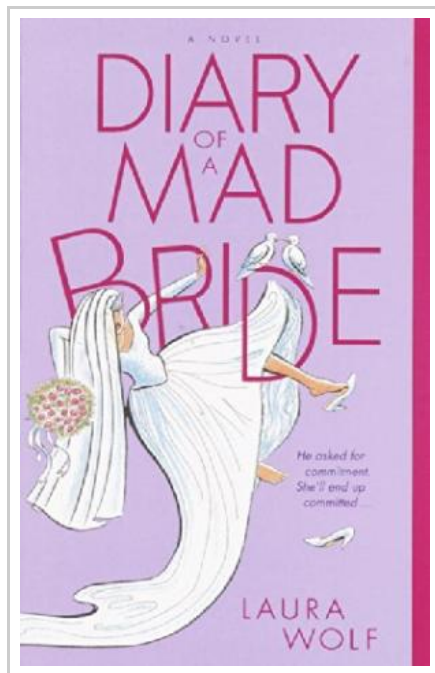




Diary of a Mad Bride
