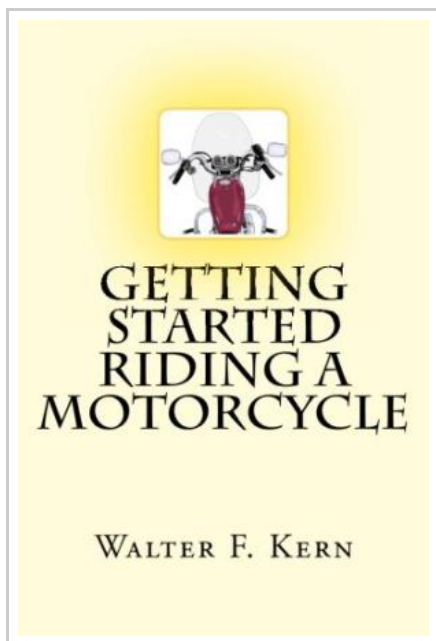




Getting Started Riding a Motorcycle (Paperback)
